

How to determine if your PC meets the Minimum System Requirements of Marport CommandView 3

As stated in the CommandView 3 user manual, the Minimum System Requirements are as follows:

OPERATING SYSTEM	Windows Vista Home Premium, Windows XP Professional
PROCESSOR	1 GHz Intel or AMD, single or dual core
MEMORY	2 GB RAM
HARD DRIVE	120 GB
GRAPHICS CARD	nVidia 8800 series card with 512 MB graphics memory or Equivalent
NETWORK	Standard Ethernet 10/100 Mb/s
SERIAL	Serial ports as required
MONITOR	Standard Resolution: 1280 x 1024 Widescreen Resolution: 1680 x 1050
INPUT DEVICE	Mouse or Trackball, with scroll wheel
CD / DVD DRIVE	CD / DVD Burner
OPTIONAL	Bluetooth, WiFi, Keyboard , Audio Speakers

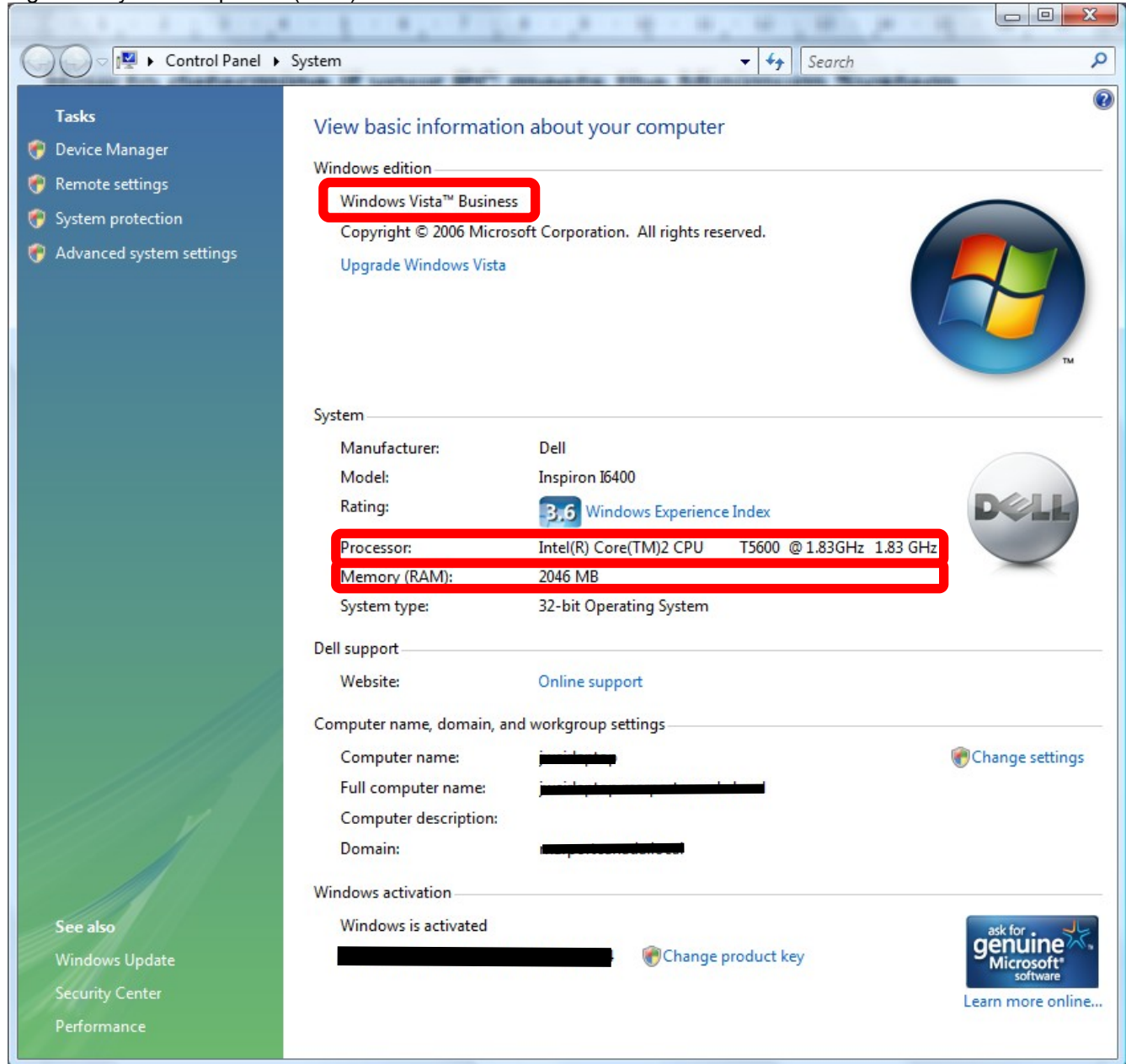
Determining your Operating System, Processor, and Ram

Figure 1: System Properties (Vista)



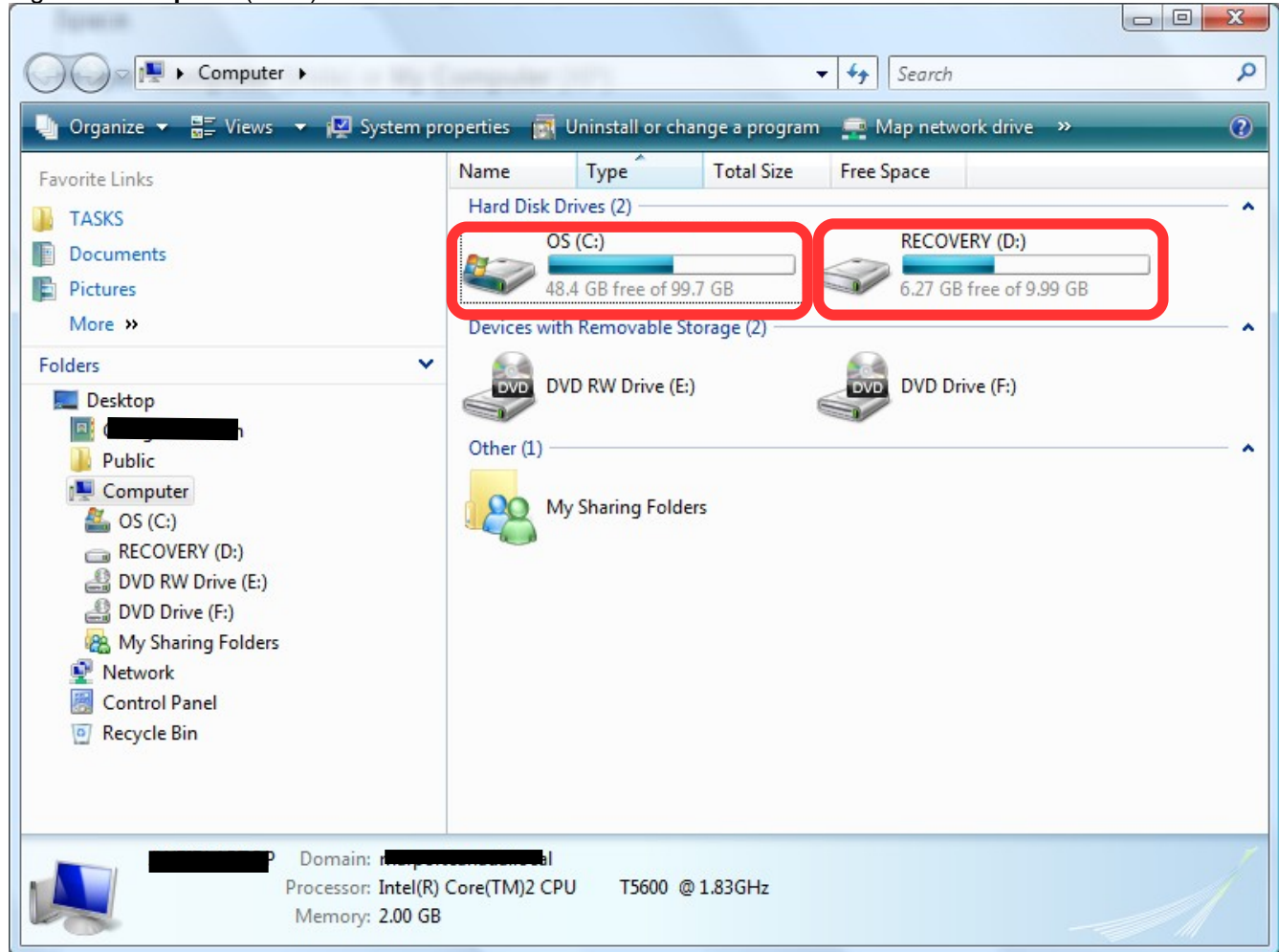
Determining your Hard Drive Capacity

Determining your Graphics Card, Network, Serial, Monitor, Input Device, CD / DVD Drive, and Optional Hardware

The **Device Manager** window, located in the **Control Panel**, shows a list of all the hardware on a PC.

In the Device Manager window

To open **Device Manager**:

1. Click Start Menu
2. Right-Click Computer (Vista) or My Computer (XP)
3. Click Properties, for Vista go to Step 5
4. Select the Hardware Tab
5. Select Device Manager
